## DUNSCROFT ALLIANCE

The Dunscroft Alliance initiative ran from 19 September 2011 to 7 October 2011. The alliance initiative consisted of a multi-agency approach including Doncaster MBC, South Yorkshire Police, St Leger Homes etc., tackling issues such as anti-social behaviour, public safety, environmental safety, crime, health etc. The Alliance project has been operating in different areas of Doncaster over the last two years and is due to move to Stainforth next year. Only certain areas of Dunscroft had been included, as these had been identified as the most socially deprived. Youth provision had been highlighted as a real problem and 28 potential volunteers to assist with youth activities have been identified. A final report on the initiative will be published shortly.

## NEW PLAY EQUIPMENT

### JUBILEE PARK, HATFIELD, STATION ROAD REC GROUND AND YORK ROAD REC GROUND, DUNSCROFT

Plans are progressing to provide play equipment on the above three recreation grounds. Tenders are at present being sought for Station Road and it is expected that a contractor will be appointed at the beginning of December. The tender process for Jubilee Park and York Road Recreation ground is due to start at the beginning of December and it is estimated that a contractor will be appointed by the end of December. All three schemes are due for completion in the early part of 2012.

## OLYMPIC TORCH ROUTE

It was announced recently that the Olympic Torch will be passing through Hatfield and Dunsville on 26 June 2012 on its journey round Britain. The Town Council hope to mark the occasion in some way—look out for details in a future edition of the Herald.

A service was once again held in St. Lawrence Church, Hatfield to commemorate those who have given their lives in various conflicts. The service was attended by members of the Royal British Legion, Caroline Flint MP, Town Councillors and members of various organisations and members of the public. Wreaths were laid at the memorial in Hatfield Cemetery and the Town Council laid a wreath at the memorial on Hatfield Moors, to Polish airmen who lost their lives during World War II.

Hatfield Band recently visited Merksplas, our twin town in Belgium. They gave a series of concerts but the highlight was performing on Remembrance Sunday at the memorial to Corporal Harper VC, who died close to the spot whilst liberating the town during World War II. The visit was also attended by members of the Twinning Committee and they held a meeting with their counterparts to discuss the forthcoming visit to Merksplas by students from Ash Hill Academy, the proposed 'Celebration of Youth' event, when young people from Merksplas will be visiting Hatfield in June 2012 and the 'Special Olympics' to be held in Merksplas in August 2012, for young people with learning difficulties.
