STATION ROAD RECREATION GROUND DUNSCROFT

Problems are still being experienced on the above recreation ground with the illegal grazing of horses and trespass by caravans. The Town Council has had meetings with the Police and Doncaster MBC's Gypsy Liaison Team to try to find a solution to the problem. A ditch has been dug coupled with the building up of the bund and more recently, bollards have been erected to try to prevent access to the recreation ground.

ABBEY PLAYING FIELD—ALLOTMENTS

Several meetings of the Allotment Committee have taken place and the Town Council have finalised the agreement to be used between the Town Council and the Allotment Association, once formed. Progress is being made on site to create the allotments. Those residents who are now on the Waiting List, will be invited to a meeting shortly to discuss the proposed arrangements

HATFIELD POWER PARK (DON VALLEY PROJECT)

The RAID Group (Residents Against Inappropriate Development) attended the Town Council meeting in July and gave an update on the situation regarding the Power Park. Of particular concern to them was noise levels on the site and they assured the Town Council that they would ensure that the whole site is measured to the same standard. Ownership of the proposed power station has passed to 2CO and representatives of this company attended the Town Council meeting in September and gave a presentation on their proposals.

HATFIELD & MERKSPLAS TWINNING ASSOCIATION

The Twinning Committee are hoping to organise a “Celebration of Youth” event when it is hoped that young people from Merksplas will visit Hatfield from 29 June to 1 July 2012, as part of the Queen's Diamond Jubilee celebrations. It is intended that the young people will stay at and enjoy the activities at Hatfield Water Park and a “Party in the Park” event is planned at Ash Hill Academy. The Committee is now busy fund-raising and seeking external funding for this event.

HATFIELD VILLAGE PLAN

The Hatfield village plan questionnaire was distributed to every household in Hatfield. Over 1000 questionnaires were returned, which the Village Plan Group was very happy about as it was more than they had anticipated. The results are now being analysed.

HATFIELD & STAINFORTH NEIGHBOURHOOD TEAM

PACT meetings are held once a month, giving the public a chance to attend and help set the priorities. They are held alternately at Ash Hill Academy (former Hatfield Visual Arts College) and Stanley Gardens Community Centre, Stainforth.
